## ACTIVITIES BOOKING TERMS & CONDITIONS

In all that follows the terms we/us/our means Boulder Adventures Ltd. and the terms you/your means the person making the booking on behalf of the group.

1. The person making the booking does so on behalf of all persons in the group. This person, by making the booking, accepts all of the booking terms and conditions, without exception, as set out herein.
2. We recommend telephoning to check availability for your chosen dates. Subsequent bookings must then be confirmed in writing. We will hold provisional bookings for 7 days by which time we must have received a 20% non-refundable deposit otherwise we retain the right to re-let the space. No booking can be considered confirmed until we have received a signed application and the deposit payment which will then be receipted by us. If we cannot accept the booking for any reason your deposit will be returned promptly but we cannot accept any liability for any delay or additional expense incurred as a result.
3. Payment of the balance of monies due must be made 4 weeks (28 days) prior to the start date of your activity, together with final confirmation of number of persons in your group. Cheques should be made payable to "Boulder Adventures Ltd." Alternatively, you can pay by debit/credit card (credit cards attract a 3% surcharge) over the phone, or by bank transfer. Failure to pay any balance due by the correct date may cause us to cancel the booking with no recompense.
4. In the event of you wishing to cancel a booking, or reduce the number of members in the group, the following charges will apply: Period prior the booking date in excess of 28 days – loss of deposit for cancelled places only; between 28 to 0 days, full booking amount payable.
5. You will be liable to us for any damaged caused, either directly or indirectly, by acts or omissions, to the equipment we lend you as part of the activity, or to our vehicles or premises used during the activity.
6. Our prices do not include any form of insurance. You are strongly recommended to arrange your own insurance to cover eventualities such as cancellation, injury, or loss of personal items. We do not accept any responsibility for any guest's property of any description, including money, luggage, electronic equipment or vehicles and their contents.
7. In exceptional circumstances we reserve the right to cancel any booking provided that, in such event, an attempt will be made to offer you an alternative activity or time. If no such alternative is available (such availability to be decided at the absolute discretion of us) you will be entitled to a full refund of all monies paid and all liability to us shall cease.
8. We do not accept any responsibility for any aspect of your activity affected by matters over which we have no control, for example weather conditions, industrial disputes, terrorism, delays, acts of God, war, quarantine, sickness or any other cause.
9. A member of our staff, or an outside contractor appointed by us, will lead your activity and their instructions are vital for your safety and enjoyment. They are empowered to stop the activity should their instructions be wilfully ignored or members of your group are acting in a way that might endanger themselves or others. You should ensure all members of your group are aware of these points.
10. The number of people taking part in the activity must not exceed the number stated on the booking form. Any additional person(s) joining the group as an observer, for example, will not be our responsibility in any way. In any event, it is usually not possible for non-participants to follow the activity due to potential access problems.
11. All persons taking part in the activity must complete, sign and date a Boulder Adventures Participation Form or, if under the age of 18, a Boulder Adventures Parental Consent Form which must have been fully completed, signed and dated by the parent or guardian of the young person(s) concerned prior to the group arriving to take part in the activity. These forms are available on our website for download or may be requested from our office. These forms are mandatory as a condition set down by our insurers.
12. You should be aware that the activities will probably be taking part in areas of natural beauty and you should tell your group not do anything that might harm that environment. Our instructor will be pleased to give advice on safeguarding the natural environment.
13. Your group must arrive at the appointed time for the start of your activity. If you arrive late it might not be possible to complete the allocated duration of the activity, or to run the activity at all, as our instructors often need to meet another group after yours. Any curtailment or cancellation will be at our sole discretion.
14. No pets are allowed on activities.
